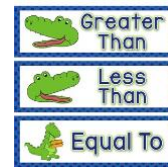
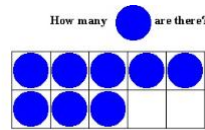

We will be working on being able to show and compare numbers to 10

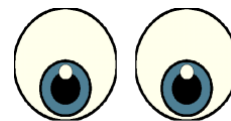


Science
