We want to create a love and enjoyment for reading in an easy and fun way.

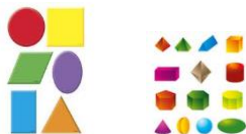

## Curriculum Corner

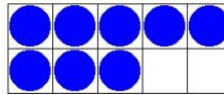
### Math

We will be studying the following digraphs this week.

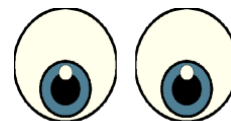
